TRAVEL INDUSTRY CHARITY EVENTS (T.I.C.E.)

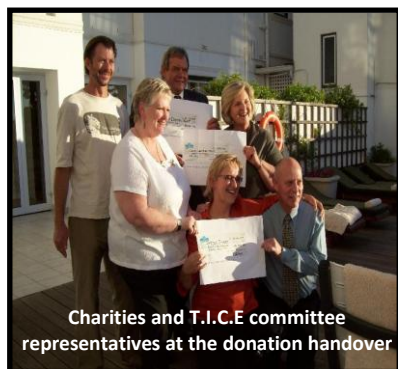
T.I.C.E. was established in 2005, in response to the 26 December tsunami disaster and the urgent need for relief funds.
